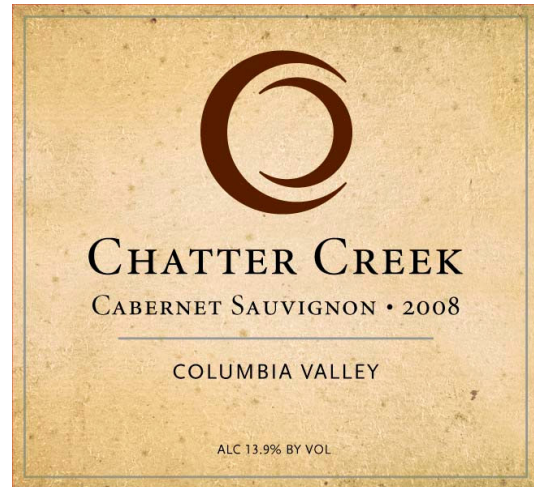


CHATTER CREEK

Cabernet Sauvignon COLUMBIA VALLEY ~ 2008

The 2008 vintage was a warm year for Washington. The effect was centered fruit, robust body, and smooth tannins, resulting in very balanced and inviting wines .

This wine shows dark purple with a ruby rim. The bright nose is intertwined with a complex mix of blueberry and black cherry, with hints of coffee, and blackberry. A medley of flavors, including blueberry, cassis and cedar, lingers in a tremendously round mid-palette. Creamy and rich, with a good mouth feel, it is, well-balanced and even, with smooth tannins and a lingering finish.
