

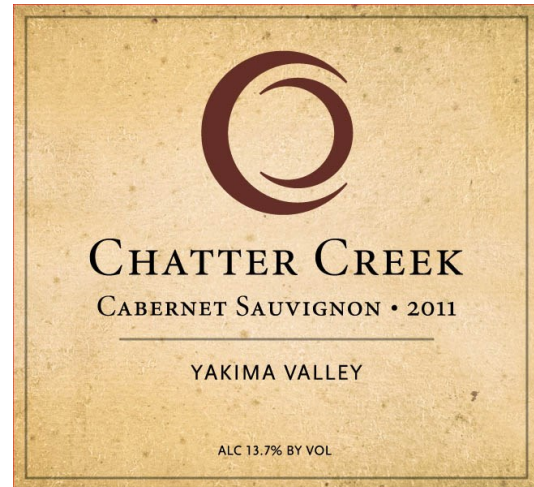
# CHATTER CREEK

**Cabernet Sauvignon 2011 ~ YAKIMA VALLEY**

The 2011 vintage was a cool year for Washington. The effect was centered fruit, tightly wound body, and smooth tannins, resulting in very balanced, age-worthy wines.

This wine shows dark purple with a ruby rim. The bright nose is intertwined with a complex mix of blueberry and black cherry, with hints of coffee and blackberry. A medley of flavors, including blueberry, cassis, and cedar, linger in a tightly wound mid-palate.

Featuring ripe flavors and a silky mouthfeel, this wine is well balanced and even, with smooth tannins and a lingering finish.
