

The 2008 Grenache was bottled after only ten months in barrel in order to preserve the freshness of fruit that is, after all, the signature of Grenache. The addition of Syrah and Mourvedre contributes an underlying backbone which balances the blend.

This year's Grenache is light ruby in color, very clear and bright. The nose is full of aromas of cranberry, fresh bread and strawberry. Racy acidity in the forward palate combines with the flavors of cranberry, raspberry, peach and a bit of hazelnut, resulting in a well-balanced, classic Grenache.
