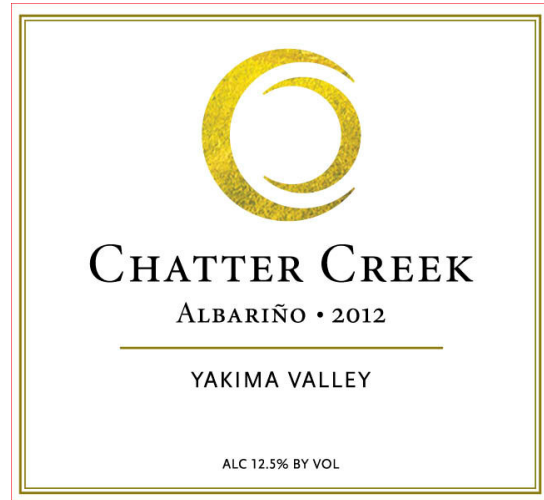


CHATTER CREEK

Abariño YAKIMA VALLEY ~ 2012

The 2012 vintage was a return to the “classic” Washington vintage. This was a welcome change from the cooler vintages of 2010 and 2011. Bud break started slightly earlier than normal but cooler temperatures through the early summer delayed veraison slightly. Though never really hot, warm and dry weather conditions lasted through mid-October and were ideal for fruit ripening our Albariño.

This wine is very floral, showing ripe pear and Fuji apple in the nose. Although the wine is dry, there are sweet flavors of nectarine, apple, and mixed melons on the palate. Cool tank fermentation helped to preserve the lively acidity that supports its long clean finish
