


## CHATTER CREEK

Sauvignon Blanc YAKIMA VALLEY ~ 2012

This vintage was a wonderfull return to "Normal" for Washington State. A slightly early spring and mild summer closed with dry conditions through mid-October. Ideal weather for fruit ripening. This was a year to make light, and lively, white wines like this Sauvignon Blanc.

This wine is very floral, showing ripe Honeydew melon and Fuji apple in the nose. Although the wine is dry, there are sweet flavors of white peach, and mixed melons on the palate. Lively acidity supports its long clean finish.
