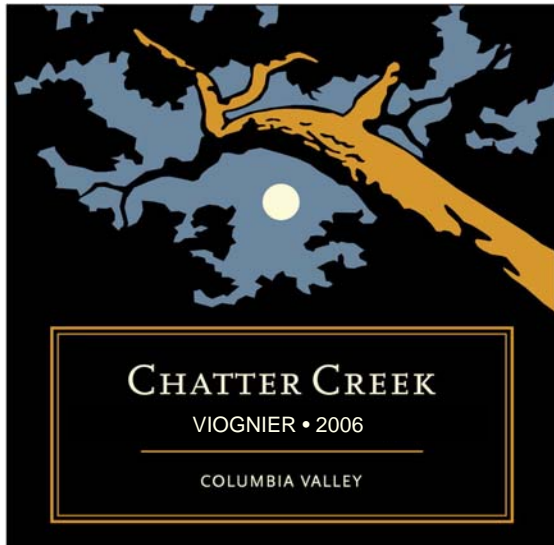

I first started making Viognier to blend into my Syrah. Luckily, I had a few gallons left after the first year that I was able to share with a few friends and customers. To me, Viognier has a wonderful balance of some of my favorite white wine characteristics – it has the acid of Sauvignon Blanc, the mouth feel of Semillon and the spice of Gewürztraminer.

The 2006 Viognier has a very floral nose with hints of peach, pear and melon. In the mouth it presents the clean flavors of apple, peach, and a hint of litchi fruit in its lingering finish. This is a well-balanced wine that is a good match with lighter foods, especially fish.
